



Applicant Criteria For Walter A. Friedly Memorial Scholarships

1. Students majoring in accounting will be eligible for scholarships to be used for the purpose of attending Florida Atlantic University, Florida State University, or the University of Florida. The applicant must be a degree-seeking student with a major in accounting in the 150-hour program. The applicant must have completed the junior year at the time they receive the scholarship. Students should not apply if they have a career field other than accounting. The applicant must be planning to sit for the CPA exam and be working towards fulfilling those requirements. Students should indicate a desire to practice in the field of accounting as opposed to other disciplines and must indicate a desire to work in Florida. Candidates for scholarships shall be citizens of the United States or hold permanent residency status and shall be residents of **Broward County Florida.**
2. Applicants should be full-time students based on the requirements of the school they are attending. In addition, scholarship recipients must be full-time students at the time they receive the scholarship.
3. **Each applicant must demonstrate financial need as determined by the university's Office of Financial Aid.** The granting of scholarships shall be on a basis of educational achievement, financial need, and demonstrated professional, social, and charitable activities. The Trustees recognize that need can vary dependent upon significant factors including geographical considerations, work-place conditions, current employment, dependents, other obligations of the student, and parental support or lack thereof. The Trustees request faculty committees be cognizant of the limited resources of the Foundation and the desire of the Foundation to assist students who are deserving and needy.
4. Candidates are eligible for up to two (2) consecutive awards.
