Three CPAmerica Firms Recognized as National Leaders and Seven Recognized as Regional Leaders in Accounting Today's Top 100

Honkamp, also a leader in the Midwest region and as a firm to watch, saw revenue growth of more than 20 percent in the past year. In 2014, the firm merged in Moline, Ill.-based Crippen, Reid & Bowen.

AKT CPAs and Business Consulting, headquartered in Salem, Ore., ranked 82 in the Top 100. AKT, a regional leader in the West region, saw revenue growth of more than 11 percent in the past year. The firm celebrated its 40th anniversary, merged in San Diego-based Douglas G. Griffin CPA, and added two new industry niches in the past year.

Beyond the Top 100 – **Gelman, Rosenberg & Freedman** was named a Firm to Watch. Headquartered in Bethesda, Md., the firm was also recognized as a regional leader in the Capital region.

Maxwell Locke & Ritter, headquartered in Austin, Texas, was recognized as a regional leader in the Southwest region and saw revenue growth of more than 13 percent.

In the New England region, firms **Gray, Gray & Gray**, from Westwood, Mass., and **Meyers Brothers Kalicka**, Holyoke, Mass., were both recognized as regional leaders.
